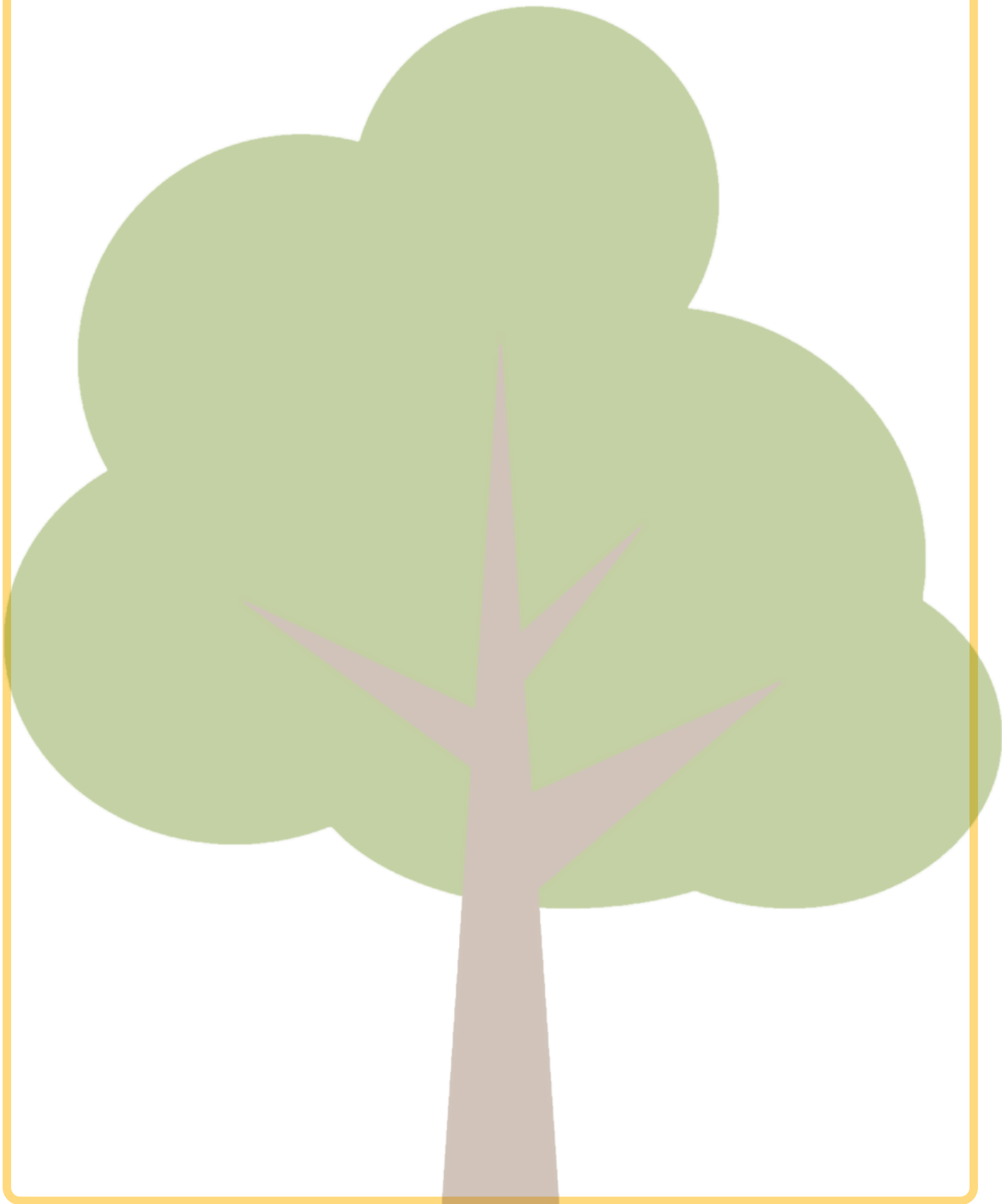
Family tree
